Traveling through the neighborhood offers numerous well-tended garden landscapes. Walkers and bikers are grateful to all of our members who care for and manage the ever-encroaching roadside foliage.

There are many places, however, where vegitation makes it dangerous for vehicular traffic and challenging for pedestrians – especially to walk when two cars are present. This is particularly important at our many road corners. Chatham safety code requires a clear sightline for the area 25 feet in each direction from the corner. The Association encourages all members to maintain their roadside space by trimming or cutting back to expose the full road.
